RESOLUTION 2018-20

The Board of Trustees of Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio met in regular session at the Miami Township Civic Building on June 25, 2018 with the following members present: Mary Makley Wolff, Karl Schultz and Ken Tracy.

A motion was made to adopt the following Resolution:

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CLERMONT COUNTY AUDITOR
PROVIDE A CERTIFICATION OF THE CURRENT TAX VALUATION
OF MIAMI TOWNSHIP AND THE AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT
WOULD BE GENERATED BY A PROPOSED 1 MIL ROAD LEVY
PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 5705.03 AND 5705.19(G)
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees ("Board") has determined that it may be necessary to levy a tax outside the ten-mill limitation for any purpose authorized by the Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, Revised Code Section 5705.03 requires that the Board certify to the county auditor a resolution requesting that the county auditor certify to the Board the total current tax valuation of the Township, and the amount of revenue that would be generated by a proposed 1 mil levy for the maintenance and improvement of roads in the Township; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees ("Board") of Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio, by authority of Chapter 504 and Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, as follows:

- SECTION 1. That the purpose of the proposed tax levy is for the maintenance and improvement of roads pursuant to Sections 5705.19(G) and 5705.25 of the Revised Code, and that the question would be submitted to the electors of Miami Township at the general election to be conducted on November 6, 2018.
- SECTION 2. To assist the Board in evaluating and levying a tax, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.03 requires that the Board certify to the county auditor a resolution requesting that the county auditor certify to the Board the total current tax valuation of the Township, and the amount of money that would be generated by a 1 mil levy.
- SECTION 3. That the Township Fiscal Officer shall certify a copy of this Resolution to the Office of the Clermont County Auditor.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for preservation of the health, safety and well-being of the residents of the Township and further that the reason for the emergency is to make sure the Board has the necessary information to put the proposed levy on the November 6, 2018 ballot.

SECTION 5. That this Board hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.



Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue

(Use this form when a taxing authority certifies a millage rate and requests the revenue produced by that rate.)

The County Auditor of Clermont County, Ohio, does hereby certify the following:

1. On June 25, 2018, the taxing authority of the Miami Township certified a copy of its resolution or ordinance adopted June 25, 2018, requesting the county auditor to certify the current tax valuation of the subdivision and the amount of revenue that would be produced by one (1.0) mills, to levy a tax outside the ten-mill limitation for road purposes pursuant to Revised Code §5705.19(G), to be placed on the ballot at the November 06, 2018, election.

The levy type is an additional.

2. The estimated property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the tax valuation of the subdivision remains constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$1,173,434.

3. The total tax valuation of the subdivision used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$1,173,434,450.
