

Dear 2026 Field User:

We are looking forward to our 2026 season. We will begin accepting field permit requests on January 2, 2026. Fields will be assigned starting on January 26th. We do our best to meet everyone's requests.

Forms That Must Be Submitted: Please fill out all required paperwork completely.

- 1. Field Request Form Please put your choices down in order of preference #1 Field/Time #2 Field/Time. There are three mound fields: MM#1, MM#2 and PR#4.
- **2. Roster Residency Summary Form -** This form determines your team's residency percentage and fee amount. **Please include the names and addresses of your team members.** On the Roster Residency Summary, there is a link to the Clermont County Auditor's office. If you are unsure whether a team member is a resident of Miami Township, run a property search; it will show the Parcel ID. If it starts with 16, 17, or 18, they are Miami Township residents.
 - *Important: We cannot process your request without your Roster and Summary Form.
- **3. Fee Schedule -** This is based on the number of players on your team and the total residency percentage.
- **4.** Copy of Team Insurance Policy This must be forwarded to us before your team's start date.

The Permit Fee:

This is a **one-time payment** per season prior to your starting date. This fee is based on your team size and residency percentage. Once the team residency percentage is determined, please see the Permit Fee page to determine the amount owed. Rosters and residency percentage will be verified by the Recreation Department. The fee can be paid with a check or cash and mailed or dropped off to the Recreation Department at the Miami Township Civic Center, located at 6101 Meijer Dr. Milford, 45150. Make checks payable to Miami Township. ***THIS FEE IS PER FIELD REQUESTED***

Priority Process:

Our priority process is based on your team's residency percentage, and it does not matter if you are a returning team. Even if a coach has consistently had fields with us, this can change based on the percentage of players who are residents.

Allotted Time Use:

We try to assign 2 nights per week to teams over 50 percent. You may request Saturday time slots for games only. There are two-hour time slots available starting at 9:00 a.m. for all fields. Once you receive your schedules, please email your game dates, and we will try to accommodate you.

Block Out Dates for Scheduling:

There will be some dates blocked out due to scheduled Township events. You will be notified of these dates in March as they are confirmed.

Field Hot Line:

Our Park and Field Condition Hotline is (513) 248-5513. Due to field conditions, certain fields may be closed, and others will remain open. Please call this number after 3:00 p.m. daily to hear updates or closings. Organizations found to be using Miami Township Fields after the Hotline has stated they are closed will have their permit revoked. Please relay this information to all coaches and parents.

* Please share our <u>Lightning Policy</u> and <u>Tobacco/Vaping Free Policy</u> to ensure all coaches, visiting teams, and parents adhere to them.

<u>Baseball/Softball Seasons:</u> Spring Season - March 2nd - July 31st
Fall Season - August 3rd - October 30th

Note: Fields open March 2nd, **weather permitting**, although some fields may remain closed in preparation for the season. The Fields will be on a weekly dragging schedule once weather permits.

Soccer Seasons: Spring Season - March 2nd - July 31st
Fall Season - August 3rd - October 30th

Note: All organizations using Miami Township Soccer Fields must provide a field layout and goal sizes needed for each field for the Spring and Fall seasons.

Lacrosse Fields: February 16th - May 29th Football Game Fields Monday through Friday

Youth Football: July 13th - November 6th Football Practice Fields
