### RESOLUTION 2018-11

The Board of Trustees of Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio met in regular session at the Miami Township Civic Center on April 17, 2018 with the following members present: Mary Makley Wolff, Karl Schultz and Ken Tracy.

A motion was made to adopt the following Resolution:

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF UNNEEDED OR OBSOLESCENT PERSONAL PROPERTY NO LONGER NECESSARY FOR TOWNSHIP USE BY INTERNET AUCTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 505.10 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 505.10(D) of the Ohio Revised Code permits the Board of Township Trustees (“Board”) to dispose of unneeded, obsolete or unfit personal property which it determines to no longer be necessary for township use by internet auction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has previously establish rules and conditions for the conduct of the internet auction via Resolution 2008-09; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has unneeded or obsolescent personal property no longer necessary for township use and shall sell the property described in Exhibit A attached hereto via internet auction.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio by authority of Section 505.10(D) of the Ohio Revised Code, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Board determines that the surplus equipment listed on Exhibit A is no longer of value and service to Miami Township.

SECTION 2: That the Board shall sell the property described in Exhibit A via internet auction.

SECTION 3: The Board does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to Section 504.10 of the Ohio Revised Code, and authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

SECTION 4: That this Board hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.


