RESOLUTION 2021-16

The Board of Trustees of Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio met in regular session at the Miami Township Civic Center on May 18, 2021 with the following members present: Mary Makley Wolff, Karl Schultz and Ken Tracy.

A motion was made to adopt the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF UNDER-SPEED, UTILITY VEHICLES OR MINI-TRUCKS ON STREETS AND HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP AND DISPENSING WITH A SECOND READING.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the “Board”) is aware that the use of under-speed vehicles such as golf carts on Township streets has become more prevalent and members of the community have expressed the desire to legally operate them on certain streets and highways in Miami Township (the “Township”); and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 4511.214 authorizes the Township to permit and regulate the use of under-speed, utility vehicles or mini-trucks, including private golf carts, on streets and highways within the Township; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 4511.215(b) permits the Township to establish additional requirements for the operation of under-speed, utility vehicles or mini-trucks on its streets and highways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio by authority of Section 4511.214 of the Ohio Revised Code, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the use of under-speed, utility vehicle or mini-truck operation on all streets and highways in the Township with a maximum speed limit of twenty-five (25) miles per hour or less, provided the vehicle be operated by a licensed driver, properly inspected, and comply with all other requirements under Ohio law.

SECTION 2: All under-speed, utility vehicles or mini-trucks being operated on streets and highways in the Township must comply with the inspection requirements established by the department of public safety under Section 4513.02 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: That this Board hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.




