RESOLUTION TO AMEND APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF MIAMI TOWNSHIP, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2024, DECLARED AN EMERGENCY AND DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING

WHEREAS, the Board has previously appropriated \$62,253,477 with the passage of Resolution 2023-047 for the year 2024; and the Supplemental Appropriation Resolution 2024-030, appropriated an additional amount of \$859,343.68
