## COMMON RULES OF CONDUCT

Good evening ladies and gentlemen and thank you for attending this public hearing.

Tonight we are scheduled to hear Case #564.

The procedure that we follow is to hear the reading of the notice of public hearing and the recommendation of the County Planning Commission and Miami Township Rural Zoning Commission, an explanation of the request from the Township Community Development Director then, statements from the applicant with regard to the proposed change and the appropriateness of the change. We will then allow adjacent property owners to express their concerns regarding the proposed change and the appropriateness of this change. We will read correspondence received relevant to this case and then allow concerned citizens to express their concerns regarding the proposed change and the appropriateness of this change. The Township Community Development Director will give a recommendation to the Board and the Board will close the open portion of the public hearing and deliberate. At this time no comments or questions will be taken from the public and we ask that you refrain from conversation so that you will be able to hear the Board's discussion.

We welcome your comments and are pleased that you have chosen to take the time to participate in this public hearing. However, we ask that you keep certain things in mind during this hearing.

First, we expect that everyone present will obey common rules of conduct and allow the person addressing the Board of Trustees to be heard WITHOUT interruption and/or interference.

Second, all comments are to be directed to the Board of Trustees. We, as a Board, have the ability to ask questions of all speakers and will do so when a member deems a question to be appropriate. We cannot conduct an orderly hearing where comments are not addressed to us.

Third, we WILL NOT tolerate shouted remarks, innuendos, clapping or gestures. If you wish to speak, you will be given the opportunity to speak one person at a time. If the Board feels that common rules of conduct are not being followed, the public comment portion of the hearing will be closed and the Board will make its recommendation without further public comment.

Finally, while we appreciate your input, it is not necessary for everyone to speak if you are going to say what already has been said. Please, if a speaker has already expressed your concerns, we have heard them and will consider them. There is no need for the same comments to be repeated.

Accordingly, we would appreciate comments which focus on the appropriateness of this request alone and as a Board we reserve the right to control this meeting and exclude comments which do not address the issues the Board of Trustees is to consider.

Thank you again for attending this public hearing. We will now begin.
