Storm Siren Test Reporting

Miami Township is seeking the community's help reporting storm siren testing throughout the township. If you can assist by [reporting a storm siren activation](#) near your home or business, please scan the QR Code or follow the link provide this valuable feedback.

Tests are normally scheduled for the first Wednesday of each month at noon. Please note that tests are postponed when severe weather is present or threatening, to avoid any confusion. Tests may also be postponed due to freezing weather conditions to avoid damaging the equipment.

Outdoor warning sirens are designed to alert individuals who are outside. When the sirens sound, go inside and seek out additional information a trusted media source. The sirens are not designed to alert people who are in homes, cars, or other buildings.

Storm sirens that are maintained by Miami Township, Clermont County. (Some addresses are approximate)

1. Branch Hill Guinea Pike & Epworth, on Branch Hill at the small utility station north of Ohio Valley Voices
2. Branch Hill Miamiville & Apache Tr, right at the intersection
3. Loveland Miamiville & Veralois, on Veralois
4. Paxton Guinea Rd & Redbird Rd, on Redbird
5. 650 Ibold & Price Rd, on Ibold
6. Branch Hill Guinea Pike & Cedar Drive, on Cedar
7. Cook & Meadow Creek, on Cook south of Meadowcreek
8. Price & Maple Ridge, on Maple Ridge
9. Buckwheat & Finch, on Buckwheat south of St. Mark's school/church
10. 131 & Eagles Way, adjacent to parking lot at Charity Lucas Field
11. Miami Meadows Park, on park drive just inside gate
12. Dry Run Rd, south of Greystone
13. 1154 US 50, front parking lot of Fire Station 28

There are many other storm sirens in the area, in all the adjoining counties, townships, and cities that are maintained by other entities.
